
Welcome to our monthly Catholic Social Teaching newsletter where we can share information each month on what the children are learning. You can share and discuss these themes as a family.

Now Farmer Dale spends more time listening to the sheep. Sid's story helps us to remember that everyone has important ideas and knows what is best for their families and communities.
